



Sanctioned Obedience Seminars

Sanctioned Obedience Seminars require the following:

1. The presenter must be an approved CDSP Obedience Judge or Representative.
2. Host organizations must complete a Seminar Application and submit it to the CDSP Coordinator for approval, together with a \$25.00 application fee.
3. Within five days after the conclusion of the seminar, the host organization must submit an attendance sheet to the CDSP Coordinator, together with a fee of \$1.50 per person. The CDSP Coordinator will forward certificates of attendance to all attendees.
4. The presenter and/or host organization must have "demo teams" at the seminar to demonstrate the various exercises in the classes being presented at the seminar.
5. Host organizations must provide all equipment necessary; jumps, ring gates, etc.
6. If time permits, the host organization may offer run-thrus for attendees and their dogs after the conclusion of the seminar. The host organization may charge an additional fee for run-thrus.
7. Host organizations must provide all attendees with copies of current CDSP Obedience Guidelines.

Host organizations must compensate the presenter for conducting the seminar. It is recommended that presenters be compensated in the amount of \$150.00 plus expenses. However, host organizations and presenters may negotiate compensation terms.
