



## Representative's Qualifications

- Support the St. Hubert's Animal Welfare Center mission to nurture the human/animal bond and foster an environment in which people respect all living creatures.
- Read and understand the St. Hubert's Dog Sports Competition Obedience Regulations. Be thoroughly familiar with the exercises and classes and maintain familiarity with new guidelines as they are issued.
- Qualify in two or more of the following areas:
  - Has acted as Show Secretary or similar position/title for at least two dog sports events in the last five years.
  - Has earned titles in Competition Obedience (any registry) or in APDT Rally Level 3.
  - Has stewarded at least three events (sanctioned or not) in Competition Obedience.
  - Is currently a dog training professional with at least two years experience in teaching competition obedience classes.
- Pass a written test on St. Hubert's Dog Sports Competition Obedience Regulations with a score of 85% or higher.
- Applicants shall fill out the Representative Application Form. The completed application, along with a non-refundable \$15 processing fee, is to be returned to the address indicated on the form.
- Upon receipt of application and verification of qualifications, the written test will be forwarded to the applicant. The completed test is to be returned to the address indicated.
- All applicants will receive prompt notification of their status. Those who are accepted will receive a St. Hubert's Dog Sports Representative License.

*\* Please note: Applicants who have not earned a competition obedience title will be required to attend a St. Hubert's Dog Sports Sanctioned Competition Obedience Seminar in addition to satisfactorily passing the written test before receiving Provisional Approval. If you have attended an St. Hubert's Dog Sports Competition Obedience Seminar prior to completing this application, please indicate date and location on the application form. If you attend after submitting this application, you must furnish this information to St. Hubert's Dog Sports within ten days of attending the seminar.*
