## Cat Supplies

## We can usually provide:

$\square$ Wet food and kibble
$\square 1$ litter box per cat (for a multi cat household 1 litter box per cat plus 1 extra)
$\square$ Litter (must use a non-clumping litter until spay/neuter surgery site is healed)
$\square$ Cat toys
$\square$ Scratcher
$\square$ Carrier designed for transporting animals

## Recommended:

$\square$ A variety of wet food (sometimes stressed cats don't want to eat, having a variety of stinky foods will entice your foster to eat)
$\square$ A litter box that can convert from an open box to a covered box. Cats can sometimes be choosy about the type of litter box they'll use. Having this type of litter box will give you options $\square$ Different types of litter (i.e. newspaper pellets and clay) Just as cats can be picky about the type of litter box they'll use, they can also favor one type of litter over another.

## $\square$ Puzzle feeder

Wand/lure toys
Batting/chasing toys like mice or crinkle balls
$\square$ Catnip toys
$\square$ Scratchers made of different materials and different levels (horizontal and vertical)
Large dog crate or spare room or spare bathroom
$\square$ Cat bed
